**Re: Extra Lesson Provision Year 11**

As you are aware, the Upper School team is committed to helping pupils achieve their full GCSE potential. We have worked with all the staff in the school to create our extra lesson programme, which is on the reverse.

These lessons are aimed at revision, and the timetable on the back of this letter indicates when the extra lessons will take place and by which teacher.

We realise that pupils will find clashes with extra lessons they want to attend. In such cases they need to negotiate with a member of staff to attend their extra lesson one week and then another the following week. We have tried to ensure the core subjects have a separate day each.

We have addressed this letter to you because we realise your son/daughter may need a little encouragement by your good selves to go to these extra lessons. You might want to keep this timetable safe and work out a programme of which extra lessons they need to attend. If you want to check attendance please telephone the individual member of staff; we all have a voicemail and can get back to you.

Extra lesson provision will also continue over Easter with our 'Easter School Programme', details of which I will send to you in due course. We have also issued pupils with a passport they should have signed by their teacher at the end of each session they attend. I am sure you will be interested to see this record of lessons they are attending.

I must stress the revision support given by school will only be effective in conjunction with your son/daughter revising themselves for which there is no substitute. Year 11 second Mocks start on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2010 and Science Modular tests are on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> and Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March. There are also 8 school weeks until the final GCSE's commence on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> May with Year 11 GCSE modern language speaking exams. On the 24<sup>th</sup> March we have 'Mock Results Day' this day simulates the real results day and gives pupils an indication of whether they are on track or not to achieve their GCSE grades. Another date for your diary is Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> March which is GCSE Preparation Evening. This is a chance to find out how to prepare for the GCSE exams, I will send you a letter about this nearer the time.
